We all want to see our kids going towards success, which is only possible through the good and proper education.

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

Space & Mars Research




Our universe was born about 13.8 or 7 billion years ago in a massive expansion called The Big Bang. The expansion blew like a gigantic balloon and big

Some places haven't got good communication facilities and transport facilities. Some places are lacking behind good education. So, there are many social problems and evils still being practiced. Some social problems are child marriage, chhaupadi pratha, deuki pratha, jhuma pratha, dowry etc.

Due to these problems, the girls are not able to enjoy their freedoms. They are given less priority than the boys. The girls are kept in a cowshed during their menstruation period. The girls are even offered to the temples and monasteries. They believe that offering a girl child to those places can help them to get rid of their sins. The girls have to give cash and expensive goods to the groom's families. The girl and her family are tortured when they are not able to offer them a dowry. People believe that when their children marry before their first menstruation is good for them. Due to this, the girls suffer from malnutrition and other diseases. The girl faces various complications and health issues in the future. The girl loses the freedom to play and learn. Not only does a girl mislay her education but she also experiences emotional difficulties. While practicing these social problems many girls have died.

Bhaktapur Flood Tripti Nepal


