IN 2023 HCC SUPPORTED THE EDUCATION OF 434 STUDENTS



THE PEAK PROGRAM SUPPORTED 41 STUDENTS IN:

- 20 in junior college (grades 11 & 12)
- 3 in technical school
- 18 in university

OUR PEAK STUDENTS:

- 75% are girls
- 80% have lost one or both parents
- 54% are from a marginalized caste or indigenous community

THE RISE PROGRAM SUPPORTED 97 STUDENTS IN:

- 53 in elementary school
- 44 in high school

OUR RISE STUDENTS:

- 65% are girls
- 85% have lost one or both parents
- 81% are from a marginalized caste or indigenous community





THE BENIGHAT STUDENT RELIEF PROJECT HELPED 296 CHILDREN, THEIR FAMILIES & SCHOOLS WITH:

- 3 food distributions
- 2 clothing and school uniform distributions
- 2 books and school supplies distributions
- 40 bench desks, 30 group tables and carpeting and cushions for 8 nursery classrooms.

PEAK PROGRAM

As our Signature Program students grew into young adults, our programs in Kathmandu evolved to support students in higher education. This year, our last two Signature Program students began college, and we combined the Signature Program and the Higher Education Scholarship Program together to become **the PEAK Program.**

The PEAK Program provides students ages 16-24 with educational scholarships for college, technical school or university and includes tuition, housing, living expenses, medical care, access to HCC's mentorship programs and inclusion in HCC's family culture. The PEAK Program students are admitted based on merit, motivation, and academic dedication.

THE PEAK PROGRAM IN 2023:

- 41 students were supported in high school, technical school & university
- 2 students graduated with Bachelor degrees





RISE PROGRAM

Our rural scholarship program has gone through a few name changes since its beginning in 2015. The program was founded to help children orphaned by the 2015 earthquakes, and today has grown to support any rural child in need. The Rural Education Scholarship Program has now been conclusively renamed as the **RISE Program**.

The RISE Program serves marginalized and impoverished children ages 5-18 in rural areas of Nepal. The Program provides educational scholarships and support for students through grade 12, keeping children safe and strengthening local communities.

THE RISE PROGRAM IN 2023:

- 97 students were supported
- 15 new students joined the program.
- 8 students graduated with high school degrees





COMMUNITY OUTREACH

HCC's community outreach projects serve rural communities with library books, educational workshops, and even internet installation at rural schools. In 2021, the Himalayan Children's Charities team in Nepal learned of a critical situation in Benighat, Dhading, a remote district west of Kathmandu. This area is home to many marginalised people and suffers from widespread poverty, food insecurity, and lack of running water and sanitation.

HCC's Benighat Student Relief Project provides food relief, clothing and school supplies to children and their families in this community. The Project also works to help local elementary schools, which often lack everything from books and desks, to toilets and potable water tanks.

In 2023, HCC's Benighat Student Relief Project:

- Completed three distributions to 300 students and their families, including school uniforms, winter clothing, hygiene items and school supplies.
- Provided five schools with needed furniture, greatly improving the learning environment for the students. In total, the schools received: 40 bench desks, 30 group tables, 115 cushions and carpeting in 8 nursery classrooms.


- University senior, Ram, interned as a chef in a Michelin starred restaurant in France


HCC'S LEGACY ENDOWMENT FUND






